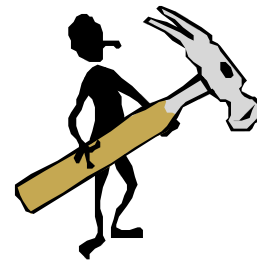

Did you know...

according to our covenants & city code...



- External storage structures made of plastic, wood, etc. may NOT be constructed on your property.
- Please keep your dogs & cats on a leash. They may NOT run loose. Call the Humane Society if there is a problem.
- Vehicles (including boats, campers, & trailers) must, when possible, be parked inside the garage. If they are outside, they must be driven at least every 7 days.
- Paint for the outside of your house may be ONLY "certain exterior earthtone hues"
- Vegetable gardens are allowed only in the back yard
- Roofs in most of our area must be wood. Please call if you are uncertain, BEFORE replacing your roof.
- Fences must be constructed of wood, iron, brick, or stone (NOT wire or chain-link)



***Questions about the covenants?

before you begin any major changes
to the exterior of your house or yard,
including a change of color, for approval***

***(NOTE: if you are just repainting the same color,
you need NOT ask for approval)***

***NOTE: We WILL be enforcing the covenants!

You may take anything there, except tires, trash or yard waste -- this year Cottonwood School will be a site to discard **appliances**, as well.
