New Omaha Dog Ordinances

The City of Omaha has passed new dog ordinances, enforced as of October, 2008:

1) Dogs can no longer be tied up alone outside for more than 15 minutes. If you have a securely fenced yard or fenced run for your dog it is ok to leave him outdoors without human supervision for extended periods of time.

2) Reckless Owners

Dog owners need to keep their pets from barking, clean up after them, contain them to the yard, walk them on appropriate leashes, license them on time and make sure they don't have too many pets.

3) If Animal Control Officers determine the dog to be Potentially Dangerous that designation lets the owners know they have a growing problem and requires them to take some steps to protect the public.

4) If you own a pitbull or other bully breed or mix as defined below you will be required to properly leash and muzzle your dog whenever he is outside, unless he is in a securely fenced yard.
