  - Paint for the outside of your house may be ONLY "certain exterior earthtone hues"

  - Rock & vegetable gardens in the front of your house are NOT allowed (only in the back yard)

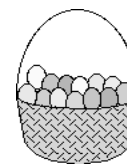
